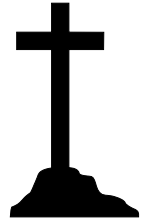

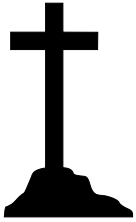
Convention Update letter

God's Peace to everyone,

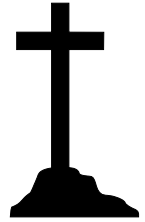

Because of other large-scale events going on in the area during the month of June, hotels and motels near the campus are filling up fast. **Also please register ASAP**. This is needed to better plan for conventions. We need to finalize numbers soon and don't want to over or under plan. This will also help speed up registration when you arrive. Parking: On Thursday the college has an art festival on campus they will have stands all over campus and lots of people. They have asked us to park in Lots K or Q. There will be shuttles used by the art festival guests that we can use also along with our carts that will be shuttling. They did suggest if you can carpool that day it would be a good idea. The rest of the days (Friday thru Sunday); there is free parking on campus except for the lots marked as pay lots, please refer to the map attached as to where the parking lots are located. Golf carts will be providing rides. There is a parking ramp close to Atwood Center that is \$1.50/hour all the time. We do not encourage use of the ramp, if you chose to use the ramp the cost is not covered by the convention.
